After receiving an NNPHI Emerging Institute grant, representatives from VtPHA, the Vermont Department of Health, the College of Medicine at the University of Vermont, and the University of Vermont Medical Center (formerly Fletcher Allen Health Care) began a two-year strategic assessment and planning process, mentored by seasoned leaders, Cindy Cameron at Michigan Public Health Institute and Amy Rohling McGee at Health Policy Institute of Ohio. Vermont Public Health Institute's leadership is currently exploring regional approaches to better serving the New England region through collaboration across NNPHI's vast network of members and partners.
