## Why Are We Here?

- Workforce Crisis
  - Aging workforce, shrinking numbers
  - Gap between skills, capacity and evolving practice
- Tremendous changes in public health
- Inattention to public health workforce
- Insufficient understanding of workforce needed to improve health
- Call to Arms—take action!

- Held series of meetings with partners
  - HRSA, practice partners, APHA, TFAH, RWJF
  - CDC programs
  - Academia
  - Public Health Institutes
- Asked key questions:
  - How is public health changing?
  - How do these changes affect the workforce?
  - What is CDC's role?

## What Did We Learn?

#### New public health—transformation

- More than just governmental public health
- Need to engage more stakeholders
- Community-focused as well as state-based
- New territory with health reform
- Stronger linkages with health care needed
- Data, data, data
- More monitoring, measuring, accountability

#### What Did We Learn?

#### Need to modernize public health workforce

- Public health needs to understand health care
- Health care needs to understand population health
- Strengthen workforce skills in the areas of:
  - Informatics
  - Collaborative leadership
  - Community engagement
  - Business processes
  - Marketing and communication
- Cross-training of existing workforce
- More career pathways into public health

#### What Did We Learn?

#### CDC's role: need to shift the balance

- Convene and lead
- Focus on more than governmental public health
- Bring together traditional and non-traditional stakeholders
- Systems-based approach—walk the talk
- Recommendations from Advisory Committee to CDC Director
