Duties include identifying, designing, and conducting analytical and research projects related to health policy issues in Mississippi, actively conducting research, as well as preparing and presenting reports, policy briefs, and papers.

A Master's Degree in health policy, public health, health care administration, economics, or other pertinent field is required along with a minimum of 2 years of programmatic, analytic, or research experience in health policy, health care administration, or public health. A PhD is preferred. Work experience should demonstrate the ability to effectively translate research into policy and include substantial experience in quantitative and qualitative research methods utilizing statistical, data base, presentation, spreadsheet, design and word processing software.
